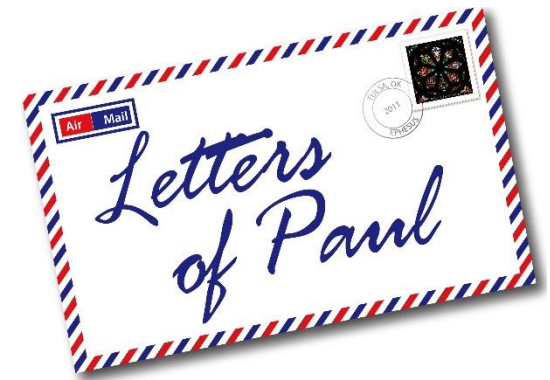

Buddy up with someone and engage in the daily readings which also include a Psalm for the day. Pray back words of the Psalm to the Lord as you interact in prayer and meditation.

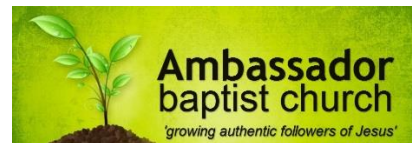
**Each Saturday from 8:30-9:30 am** at McDonalds on College Ave you can gather to reflect with others on the week's readings. As the weather permits we will head out prayer walking seeking to pray for and engage our neighbours.

### Reading Tips

1. **Prioritize time for reading.** We average one chapter of Paul's writings and one Psalm per day. Find a time of day when you can regularly devote about 20 minutes to reading and reflecting.
2. **Pray for God's Spirit to help you understand and apply what you read.** Ask for one particular thought, phrase or teaching to stick in your heart while reading.
3. **Take notes on what interests you.** You could simply summarize the day's reading in your own words. Or you could trace an important theme through the reading, and reflect on why Paul is bringing emphasis to this. What is the LORD asking of you in response to reading this daily passage?
