Each Saturday from 8:30-9:30 am at McDonalds on College Ave you can gather to reflect with others on the week's readings.

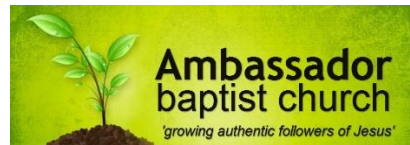
### Reading Tips

1. **Prioritize time for reading.** We average three chapters of Scripture reading each day. Get to the Scriptures first thing in the morning before your phone. Have a quiet place to read and reflect. Give time for meditation.
2. **Pray for God's Spirit to help you understand and apply what you read.** Ask for one particular thought, phrase or teaching to stick in your heart while reading.
3. **Take notes on what interests you.** You could simply summarize the day's reading in your own words. Or you could trace an important theme through the reading, and reflect on why the Lord is highlighting this. What is the LORD asking of you in response to reading this daily passage?
